Title: Christians Are Prayer Warriors

Text: Acts 2:42

How Often? Constantly

Acts 1:14 - They all joined together constantly in prayer, along with the women and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with his brothers.

Pray Regularly with Other Christians

Acts 3:1 – One day Peter and John were going up to the temple at the time of prayer—at three in the afternoon.

Pray Expecting Results

Acts 4:31 – After they prayed, the place where they were meeting was shaken. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and spoke the word of God boldly.

Prayer Is a Priority

Acts 6:4 – and will give our attention to prayer and the ministry of the word.”

Pray for the Impossible

Acts 9:40 – Peter sent them all out of the room; then he got down on his knees and prayed. Turning toward the dead woman, he said, “Tabitha, get up.” She opened her eyes, and seeing Peter she sat up.

Pray for Deliverance from Evil

Acts 12:5 – So Peter was kept in prison, but the church was earnestly praying to God for him.

Pray Anywhere

Acts 16:25 – About midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God, and the other prisoners were listening to them.

Pray Anytime

Romans 1:10 – in my prayers at all times; and I pray that now at last by God’s will the way may be opened for me to come to you.

Pray with Thanksgiving

Philippians 4:6 – Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God.
