Title: What is revival?

Text: Psalm 85:1-7

¹You, Lord, showed favor to your land; you restored the fortunes of Jacob. ²You forgave the iniquity of your people and covered all their sins. ³You set aside all your wrath and turned from your fierce anger. ⁴Restore us again, God our Savior, and put away your displeasure toward us. ⁵Will you be angry with us forever? Will you prolong your anger through all generations? ⁶Will you not revive us again, that your people may rejoice in you? ⁷Show us your unfailing love, Lord, and grant us your salvation.

Revival - an awakening, in a church or community, of interest in and care for matters relating to personal religion. an evangelistic service or a series of services for the purpose of effecting a religious awakening: to hold a revival.

Signs Indicating the Need for Revival

1. Lack of reverence for God.
2. Love of pleasure over love for God.
3. Less attendance at worship.
4. Low level of compassion for the unsaved.
5. Lost desire to read and study God's Word.
6. Lukewarm spirituality.
7. Loss of morality.
8. Lack of stewardship.
