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Title: Steps for Making the Right Plans for 2020

Text: Matthew 6:33-34

Good words to remember when making plans.

Seek God's will first.

Matthew 6:33 - But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well. 34 Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own.

Set priorities with God's Word as your guide.

Set priorities by covering your plans with prayer.

Remain faithful in worship and stewardship.

Share the gospel.

Expect God to do great things.

Psalm 37:4 - Delight yourself in the LORD and he will give you the desires of your heart.

Trust God to fulfill His will in your life even if it puts you out of your comfort zone and your perceived plans.

Jeremiah 29:11 - For I know the plans I have for you," declares the LORD, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.

Be patient by waiting on God.

Psalm 27:14 - Wait for the LORD; be strong and take heart and wait for the LORD.
